Dear Resident,

Please welcome your new, single-stream recycling bin.

WHAT TYPE OF MATERIAL CAN BE ACCEPTED IN YOUR NEW RECYCLING CONTAINER?

- All Papers (newsprint, magazines, cardboard, office paper, cereal boxes, etc.)
- Glass (beverage and food containers only)
- Plastic Containers (Food and beverage containers, water bottles, laundry detergent bottles, milk jugs, etc.)
- Tin and Aluminum food and beverage containers.

WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR OLD BINS:

Residents may keep their old bins if they chose; however, they will not be serviced as part of recycling pick up. There will also be a collection station setup at the township building for containers to be dropped off and recycled. Please do not leave your container at the curb to be collected for recycling.


WHEN DOES THE NEW AUTOMATED SERVICE BEGIN?

Thank you in advance for your cooperation.


PLACE RECYCLABLES IN THIS CONTAINER

Please place your containers with the lids opening towards the street with a minimum of three feet between each container and other objects.



THIS NEW EQUIPMENT IS DESIGNED TO BE AUTOMATED SO THE DRIVER DOES NOT LEAVE THE CAB. THE TRUCK HAS A MECHANICAL ARM THAT REACHED THE BIN SO IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU PLEASE FOLLOW THE PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS ON THE LID EACH TIME YOU PLACE THE BIN OUT FOR PICK UP PREVENTING ANY INTERRUPTION IN SERVICE.

What to Recycle?



RECYCLE RIGHT:

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED IN YOUR NEW RECYCLING BIN:

- Food waste
- Foam cups, containers and shipping materials
- Laminated paper
- Plastic Bags (please take these to your local grocery store for recycling)
- Plastic take-out containers
- Plastic plates, cutlery, straws
- Plastic food wrap
- Clothing
- Greasy or sharp metal
- Broken office supplies
- Ceramics and broken glass
- Fluorescent bulbs and tubes
- Incandescent light bulbs
- Electronic Waste
- Sharps or needles
